1.0 Background

The Government of Maldives, through the Ministry of Climate Change, Environment and Energy (MECCT), has successfully obtained a grant from the Green Climate Fund (GCF) for a three-year project to build capacity to advance National Adaptation Plan (NAP) process in Maldives. The UN Environment Programme (UNEP) is the Delivery Partner for the project, with the role of supporting and overseeing the project implementation.

NAPs are focused on medium- and long-term adaptation planning. Objective of the project is to reduce the vulnerability of the Maldives' population to climate change impacts through enhanced capacity for planning, implementing and monitoring adaptation interventions.

The NAP project provides support for the elaboration of two project concept note on adaptation for submission by the country NDA to the Green Climate Fund (GCF). The Concept Note will be developed in accordance with GCF guidance on Concept Notes and address the following:

- Development context;
- Objective of the concept note;
- Climate change impacts and risks to be mitigated;
- Baseline drivers of vulnerability;
- Adaptation approach to be further investigated.

In this regard the Ministry is seeking the service of an individual consultant (national) to support the international consultant team to support the development of a project concept note (health Sector) under NAP Process.

2.0 Tasks and Deliverables

2.1 Tasks

- Support the international consultants during the field mission. This includes collaboratively identifying information requirements relevant to the consultant's deliverables, and producing a mission report summarising responses received during consultations sector relevant findings.
- Desk review of literature including policy documents, sectoral plans, and research materials in the context fisheries sector
- Draft a health Sector Assessment Report for the proposed project. The report should include option analysis on the following areas:
 - Integrating green climate smart technologies into health infrastructure and services
 - Enhancing the communicable disease, non-communicable disease, mental health illnesses
 and injuries surveillance system to integrate climate information to enable early warning
 of health risks
 - Integration of green and healthy innovative solutions to community settings to control vector borne diseases such as mosquitoes, transmitting communicable diseases
 - Implementation of healthy City/island concepts
 - Strengthening Health Services Emergency Response to extreme climate events
- Recommendations for interventions to be undertaken under the proposed project, including sitespecific technical designs and localities, with site-specific maps.
- Contribute to the analysis and report writing led by the international consultant team, and presenting
 of results

2.2 Deliverables

- Mission Report
- Health Sector Assessment Report
- Options Analysis Report

Note: The consultant is required to provide written contribution to the analysis and report writing led by the international consultant team, and presenting of results.

3.0 Required Profile

In executing this TOR, the consultant is expected to meet the following requirements.

a) Academic qualification

o Minimum Qualifications: Masters' degree in climate science, Public Health, Health Economics, Environmental Science, or any other area relevant to the proposed assignments

b) Experience

- o At least 7 years of experience in a relevant area
- o Demonstrated experience in stakeholder engagement and field research
- o Demonstrated experience in the elaboration, preparation and design technical reports and documents on climate impacts on health sector. (submit samples or weblinks of samples)
- Demonstrated experience in preparing project concepts, notes, proposals in accordance with the guidelines of funding agencies
- Must have excellent speaking, reading, report writing and presentation skills in Dhivehi and English

4.0 Duration

The duration of the contract shall be 5 months. (40 Input days)

5.0 Duty Station and Expected Places to travel

This consultancy is a home-based exercise. However, physical meetings are expected to be arranged at MCCEE, or in a conferencing facility in Male', Maldives. Any travel arrangements required will be facilitated by PMU.

6.0 Scope of Price Proposal and Schedule of Payments

Contract will be as per output-based lump-sum scheme supported by a breakdown of costs as per the template provided regardless of extension of the herein specific duration.

The total amount quoted shall be all-inclusive lump-sum and include all costs components required to perform the deliverables identified in the TOR, including professional fee or any other applicable cost to be incurred in completing the assignment.

The payments shall be released upon submitting the required deliverables/outputs by the consultant, and upon the clearance of the deliverable as satisfactory by the NAP project and UNEP Focal Point as per agreement for each report in accordance with a set time schedule to be agreed in the contract.

The weights given to the Technical and Financial Proposals are:
